

Screeener (Cinema) DVD of Leo Murray's Film: WAKE UP, FREAK OUT — THEN GET A GRIP

Availability, ordering and shipping information

The screener DVD are set up specifically for the film to be displayed in cinemas. Each DVD includes only one version of the film. The screener versions available to date do not include subtitles, except for the translation of the title and additional credits. However, these ("screener") versions can also be viewed on computers or on most home cinema equipment. If the equipment used can only read +R (or -R, respectively) recordable DVD, specify the type required. If you received only one DVD per version (e. g. in "+R" format) and it does not work, you might want to order a copy in the other recordable format (e. g. in "-R"). Screener versions are set up according to standards which apply in Switzerland for cinema-DVD. Therefore, it is important to observe the instructions for *using the screener DVD* below.

Home cinema DVD

It is planned to release home cinema DVD of the film with several languages and subtitles on the same DVD. The picture quality of the home cinema DVD shall be equal to that of the screener version. A Spanish voice version is in preparation. An Italian voice version is planned. Subtitles are planned for several other languages.

Screeners versions on other media than DVD

If the cinema equipment requires the film on media other than DVD (e. g. DigiBETA, e. g. for TV) inquire via <http://carbondowntozero.org/contact/>. Make sure to inquire early. Very high quality screener versions on other media than DVD can be produced. Yet, they are not on stock and may take weeks to produce.

IMPORTANT: Using the screener DVD

When the DVD is inserted, the start/menu screen should be displayed automatically. However, **the start/menu screen is all blank black and there is only one push button: that's the entire screen.** To start the film you have to either "mouse click" on the black screen or press "enter"/"return" on a computer, or choose "select" (rather than "play", perhaps "select" then "play") on a DVD player. The film should then start. Be sure to inform the operator. He or she might be confused otherwise.

There is no AUDIO_TS folder in the screener DVD shipped from carbon down to zero! It's there in master DVD, but absent in the copies normally shipped. The effect is caused by the copy software used. The AUDIO_TS folder would be empty anyway. Specifically request an original "master" screener DVD if you need to have an AUDIO_TS folder. If you are not sure and cannot check in time, you might want to request master DVDs of both +R and -R types. The cost for master screener DVD is 30 Euros per disc.

English version

The english version on the screener DVD differs from the english version which is viewable and downloadable from the film website <http://wakeupfreakout.org/film/tipping.html> (direct download: <http://wakeupfreakout.org/film/TippingPoint-1.avi>) in a few minor points:

- The mix of the voice and the background sound is more conservative: I. e. the very loud low and very loud high frequencies in the background sound were tempered. Therefore, the sound level — and more important: the voice (speech) level — is higher.
- The title (WAKE UP — FREAK OUT) is displayed at the start.
- The first spoken words: ("Give me hat!") are not there.
- The DVD version is larger and of better image quality than the downloadable or web-tv versions.

There might be more small differences, which the author of this document ignores.

According to the producer (Leo Murray; leo@wakeupfreakout.org) displaying and distribution of the film is encouraged and there is no copyright problem as long as the use of the film is not commercial. In case of doubt, inquire with Leo Murray. The DVD is not copy protected. Leo Murray kindly asks for the (prospective or retrospective) reporting of public viewings of the film and multiplication/distribution of the DVD. carbon down to zero! keeps track of the DVDs duplicated and distributed. Make sure to create a video DVD (but not a data DVD) when duplicating the screener DVD to preserve the full functionality of the disc. The screener DVD provided by carbon down to zero! were duplicated with Skysoft DVD Copy. This (mac OSX) software (<http://www.iskysoft.com/dvd-copy-mac.html>) allows a few trial discs before purchasing the software.
